Background/Introduction

The Responsible Financial Officer is obliged to make arrangements for the Exercise of Electors’ Rights in relation to the accounts including the opportunity to inspect the accounts, books, and vouchers and display or publish any notices and statements of account required by Audit Commission Act 1998, or any superseding legislation, and the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015.

Details

The required period for the Exercise of Electors’ Rights is 30 working days inclusive and must include the first working days of July 2018. This period is set by the RFO and for 2018-19 will be 11 June – 20 July 2018. There is a Full Council meeting on 5 June at which the audit and accounting information, including the Annual Return will be considered.

Recommendations/Decision

1. To note that the RFO will be publishing the required notices and sending them to councillors to advertise in their wards.
2. To note the period for the Exercise of Electors’ Rights will be 11 June – 20 July inclusive.
