We have a statutory duty to monitor air quality to a standard dictated by legislation (The UK Air Quality Regulations <u>http://www.legislation.gov.uk/uksi/2010/1001/contents/made</u>)

We are required to put the results of these efforts into an annual report which has to be submitted to DEFRA for approval. All our reports are published annually & made available on our website, as is a lot of other information about air quality, at https://www.eastsuffolk.gov.uk/environment/environmental-protection/air-quality/
