## **BOTTLE BANKS**

During the lock down and changing in working patterns this year we have seen an increase in contamination of our blue bins , sometimes as high as 20 pct

A continuous issue being glass bottles .

This is very frustrating as we constantly promote glass bins and how residents should dispose of bottles - and I know town and parish councils continue to encourage the use of these bins

Infact its really important as glass in a bottle bin is closed recycling , ie this is then processed and becomes another bottle - glass just placed in the black bin ends up as aggregate and is 'recylined' only once. Glass in the blue bin contaminates the recycling load and it is then processed as general waste .
