If you would be able to let me know if this would be possible I would most grateful.



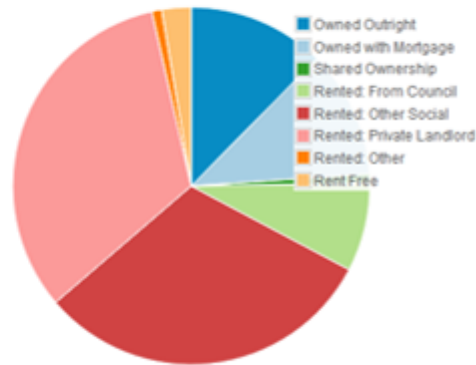
Housing Tenure
