Public Space Protection Orders – Dog Controls in the East Suffolk District

I am writing to you to advise that the Council is considering making a Public Space Protection Orders to require dogs to be kept on a lead on specified land in the East Suffolk District.

The areas to which these controls are proposed to be applied are set out in the schedule to the draft order.

That schedule comprises a revised version of that contained in the PSPO which formerly applied only to the Northern part of the East Suffolk District (i.e. in the former Waveney District).
