Constitution

1. TITLE:

The peoples Carpet Bowls Club

2. PURPOSE:

To play carpet bowls as governed by the rules of the English Carpet Bowls Association. In matches and tournaments involving other clubs, play will be according to the rules of any association with which the club is affiliated.

3. MEMBERSHIP:

Membership shall be open to all Residents in Lowestoft. Those outside the area may join at the discretion of the committee.

4. RULES OF PLAY:

All members are entitled to volunteer to play in matches or tournaments, but the Team Captain will choose teams from among those who are willing to play.

Members obliged to sit out at club sessions should only sit out for five ends.

5. MANAGEMENT:

The managing committee which is elected at the Annual General Meeting consists of a Chairman a Treasurer a Secretary and three other members. It will meet at least 3 times a year. A quorum shall be four members. (A club captain may be co-opted from within the committee)

6. FINANCE:

The financial year shall be from the 1 March to the 28 February. The A.G.M shall be held during April if practical.

An annual subscription is charged and a fee for each two hour session. At the discretion of the Treasurer these sums may be reduced e.g. for non-playing members of Juveniles. All fees to be approved at the A.G.M.

Inclusion and Respect

We aim to ensure that every member of the Peoples Carpet Bowls Club is made to feel welcome and included at our meetings and events.

Sexist, racist, homophobic, transphobic or otherwise inflammatory remarks and behaviour are not acceptable. These constitute harassment, and have no place in the club.
