There are hardly any people who wait for the bus at that stop anyways, maybe ever 2 passengers. Seems such a waste of money, and could be better else spent on other things, perhaps another community hall to keep children out of mischief.

Note from the Clerk:

came in to see Colin Butler today. She presumed he was here. She said she has good intelligence that he is pushing for a bus shelter and nobody wants it. It would be outside of her house. She has just had to get an expensive wall jetwashed owing to graffiti which cost a lot of money. They had a bus shelter and a seat before and it was removed owing to all the drinking, smoking, and drug-taking, vandalism and anti-social behaviour.

If this bus shelter goes up she will not be able to go out at night. She would be very scared.

She says there have been other contacts with 'the Council', a neighbour has been in contact but she says only the neighbour's partner received a response.
