Subject: The installation of games tables in the Town Council's parks

Background/Introduction

At its meeting on 15 November 2022, the Parks and Open Spaces Sub-Committee considered the concept of installing games tables in the Town Council's parks and open spaces. The Sub-Committee supported this in principle and asked the Assets, Inclusion and Development Committee to consider appropriate locations and specific designs.


Details


The games tables are picnic tables, available in adult and junior sizes:



A range of designs are available, including games (Snakes and Ladders, Chess, Draughts, etc) and educational themes (Green Cross Code, ABCs, Solar System etc), or completely bespoke options are also available:







Although games tables are likely to enhance any space they are in, the Project and Committee Clerk has primarily looked at where additional seating is required when making suggestions for their locations. The Council has already approved a bulk purchase of benches for the following locations:

- Sparrows Nest Two 'bluebell' bench seats and five standard bench seats.
- Belle Vue Park Five standard bench seats, five standard picnic tables and two wheelchair accessible picnic tables.
- Britten Road play area Two standard picnic benches and one wheelchair accessible picnic bench.
- Gunton Community Park Four standard picnic benches and one wheelchair accessible picnic bench.
- Rosedale Park Three standard bench seats, four standard picnic benches and one wheelchair accessible picnic bench.
- Thirlmere Walk play area Four standard picnic benches and one wheelchair accessible picnic bench.

These benches have been delivered and installation is being rolled out in stages. With this in mind, the Project and Committee Clerk has made the following suggestions regarding the purchase of games tables:

		the Sensory Garden, and as such this theme could influence the design of the games table. For example, the standard Snakes and Ladders format could be adapted to include characters/themes from the Alice in Wonderland story.
		Additionally, a Winter Garden further down the park is also under consideration, and may benefit from additional seating or a games table.
Bentley Drive Play Area	Bespoke nature-themed educational or games table.	The refurbishment of the Bentley Drive play area has been instructed. The play area will have a nature theme, and although information panels to identify birds and trees in the area will be included, a games table with an educational wildlife panel or game would still enhance the site, particularly as seating is lacking in this

Full Council has approved the refurbishment of the Cotman Close play area in the current financial year, budget permitting. The specification and any theme for the new play area will be considered by the Assets, Inclusion and Development Committee at its meeting on 5 December. The site would benefit from additional seating, and a bespoke bench to match the theme of the play area would enhance the site.
