Water bottle refill stations on seafront - these could be placed outside each of the toilet blocks and East Point Pavilion to utilise the plumbing. I saw these in Scotland - <u>Top Up Tap Map - Scottish Water</u>

There are now over 70 of our bright blue Top Up Taps across the country, from Shetland and Stornoway to the Scottish Borders, in cities and towns, parks and beaches – check out our map to find out where your nearest Scottish Water Top Up Tap is and #TopUpFromTheTap.

Since the installation of our first bright blue top up tap outside the Scottish Parliament back in 2018, the expanding network of Top Up Taps has helped save the equivalent of over one million single-use plastic bottles going into circulation through people quenching their thirst by topping up their refillable bottle from one of our Top Up Taps.

Remember to take your refillable bottle with you when you're heading out and about, so you can stay refreshed on the go – it's great for your health, your pocket and the planet.
