| Key issues discussed at the meeting(s) (relevant to LTC and its constituents) | This being the AGM of Line Group North, most of the itinerary revolved around re-election of officers (Trevor Garrod chair; Tim Miller vice-chair), finance and governance. Suffolk County Council handles the accounts, but was criticised for tardy payments of both subsidies and claims for expenses. The East Suffolk Line has three groups – North, South and Felixstowe. There has not been a Community Partnership Officer for over a year to administer the three groups. SCC has re-advertized the post more widely, and at a higher salary (if any Town Councillor fancies the job). The ESTA information leaflets, for which LTC contributed towards the printing cost of that for Lowestoft & Oulton Broad, are now being distributed around the town. | |
