Event Overview

<u>Norfolk and Waveney Mind's Festival of Kindness</u> was created during lockdown and brought to life in 2023 in collaboration with Lowestoft Town Council as a way of bringing people together to celebrate kindness and it's benefits on mental health.

The impact of a kind word or gesture can be felt in both generating the kindness and receiving it. Even witnessing kind acts can boost our mood. Kindness has the potential to bring people together even in the most trying of times and as we know connection is often so important for mental wellness.

Our 'real life' Festival of Kindness, hosted at the Sparrows Nest in Lowestoft, will aim to promoteg this message using a variety of content often seen at festivals-wellbeing, art and music, encouraging people to connect, spread the kindness, whilst enabling us to raise awareness of mental health, our charity and others, and provide a range of information and resources.

Up to 84% of people will experience a mental health problem at some point in their lifetime, so the event will be targeted at all people living in Norfolk and Waveney, with a focus on the Lowestoft community and their needs, and will be suitable for families too.
