Lowestoft Maritime Museum

The museum, after careful consideration by the trustees and in consultation with the volunteers did not re-open last year as hoped for, as too many volunteers still felt too vulnerable.

However, a small working party continued to attend the museum and completed the ongoing yearly maintenance programme, and installed various safety upgrades which have enabled the volunteers to now feel safe enough to return this year.

The museum reopened to the public on Easter Friday, with the hope that we will now remain open for the full season, until the end of October, though some of our volunteers have 'retired' so we may find that we cannot open every day, unless more volunteers are forthcoming.
