Plaisir is a Commune in North-Central France, 25 miles west of Paris, with a population of roughly 31,000 people. In May, Plaisir is celebrating the fortieth anniversary of one of their Twinnings. Two of our members will attend and will have the opportunity to sell some British produce and meet delegates from all of the other Twin Towns.

When we feel safe we will start up local events again. We aim to have an event each month. This will include a boules competition, film nights and social dinners.
