Following the success of our previous Yellow Fish project with the Environment Agency in Saxmundham, Halesworth and Framlingham, we are currently delivering a second Yellow Fish project in Woodbridge, Felixstowe and Lowestoft. This project is focussed on litter and in particular cigarette butts, as they often end up passing through the surface water drains and into the local water bodies.

The yellow spray painted fish that you kindly allowed us to paint by the surface drains worked really well previously and were an effective tool in promoting the key message of 'only rain down the drain' to the local community. I wondered if it would be possible for us to do the same in areas of Woodbridge, Felixstowe and Lowestoft please? They will be temporary as before and last up to 3 weeks. The project is running until end of March 2019.

We are targeting the following roads:

Felixstowe:

- Kimberley Road
- Garrison Lane
- Naction Road
- Payne Street
- Horn Hill
- Undercliffe Road West
- Chaucer Road
- Langer Road

Lowestoft:

- London Road
- Kirkley Rise
- Salisbury Road
- Bruce Street
- John Street
- Carlton Road

Woodbridge:

- Thoroughfare
- Brook Street
- New Street
- Little St John's Street

It would be brilliant if we are able to and would really help to engage the local community on littering and is a reminder that whatever passes through the drain ends up in the local water body.
