CEFAS

This is the latest from Sarah Carter (25th July)

- **Parking** – We did have the car-park open for a few weeks, but it is now closed (and being bulldozed as I speak!). The coming weeks are going to be a real strain on local parking, but it is also peak holiday time here at Cefas and we have higher numbers of people cycling in over the summer, both of which should slightly mitigate things.

- **On-Site works - Car Park area and Palais Block site** – This is now being stripped of surface and over the next few weeks services in this area are being diverted. We are expecting another week of the car park being removed (which is quite noisy), but after that I think things should quieten down. The main entrance has now been closed off and deliveries are getting on-site via Kensington Road.
- **Ground Break Event** – This went really well and was covered in the Lowestoft Journal .It was great to work with the Seagull on this and hold a small gathering there following the ceremony.
- **Neighbours Newsletter** – Morgan Sindall our contractors will be putting out a monthly newsletter for neighbours, during the duration of the programme. The first one is ready to go and attached above. They are giving a brief update on works and it provides contact details for both their office and Cefas Estates team.
- **Muster points** – We will be having a fire drill in the next few days and our new muster point (during works) is on the top promenade adjacent to Kensington Gardens
