Thank you for your reply and it's so great to hear that you are open to the idea of a pump track facility. Unfortunately, I'm away next week (half term) as my family and I are heading to Manchester for some sessions at British Cycling. I would really like to attend your meeting but with sessions and hotels already booked I don't want to start cancelling things this late in the day.

I've attached some info on pump tracks that I received from Clark and Kent (Pump track page 22 section 6). They build some of the best tracks in the world including world champs and the London Olympics 2012. I spoke to them earlier this year for some quotes etc, all track builders can accommodate to the size of land that we have.

I also set up a social media page in December from the suggestion of local authority. This was set up to gain interest and support for the project, within the last few weeks it has already gained around 130 likes. I've had lots of messages from riders and parents who are really keen on the idea. I've also spoken to cycling shops in the area and young adults as I work in education.

British Cycling are really keen to help and offer some funding which is great news. If this idea does go ahead I could arrange for British Cycling to visit and discuss funding options as well.

My contact at Local authority is Sarah Shinnie. She has been very supportive and really wants to see this project developed in the area. This could be a huge benefit to Lowestoft as there is nothing like it in the area.

Please let me know if you need any further information and I would be more than happy to attend any other meetings in the future. I would love to see this project developed and with the current support, I really hope this can happen.
