

SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF WAVENEY) (STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2018 (LOWESTOFT) (U4006 STUBBS WOOD, B1385 CORTON ROAD AND U4040 LYNDHURST ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (VARIATION NO. 11) ORDER 202-

Suffolk County Council proposes to make the above order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which shall substitute revision 1 of Map Tile AJ197 in place of revision 0 of the same map tile and revision 2 of Map Tile AG196 in place of revision 1 of the same Map Tile, as amended. The effect of this will be to introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' on:

- The eastern side of Corton Road for 17 metres in northerly direction and 17 metres in a southerly direction from the centre of its junction with Lyndhurst Road;
- Both sides of Lyndhurst Road from its junction with Corton Road for 12 metres in an easterly direction; and
- Both sides of Stubbs Wood from the existing double yellow lines for 10 meters in a north easterly direction.

A copy of the draft order and plans showing the road affected, together with a copy of the Council's reasons for these proposals, can be provided via email only, with requests for documents to be sent to diana.ramalho@suffolk.gov.uk. Unfortunately, these cannot be viewed at our offices or made available for viewing at local libraries as normal due to ongoing restrictions in place due to Covid-19.
