About your project		
Please provide details of the project and how the project will benefit the people of Lowestoft post COVID-19 pandemic (250 words max).	The South Pier was closed for public use by Waveney District Council in 2013 after being open for 167 years to save money, it remained closed for two years. Peter Aldous MP and Danny Steel Chair of Lowestoft Vision were approached by the Lowestoft Sea Anglers disabled section and asked if they could put pressure on WDC to get the South Pier re-opened. Many of the disabled anglers could only fish from the Pier so its closure was a great blow to them not only because of the loss of fishing as an activity but for many the loss of contact with other disabled anglers.  Despite our efforts WDC were not able to reopen the Pier so with the help of others Peter and Danny set up a Company Limited by Guarantee and negotiated a lease that would run to June 2021 with the owners Associated British Ports at a peppercorn rent. They raised the money to cover the cost of setting up the Company, the legal and accountancy fees and the Public Liability Insurance and re-opened the site in July 2015. If we are not able to raise funds, then we will have no choice other than to close the Pier.  In 2019 we started working with the Steve Eggleton of Via Beata who represents a faith organisation that has commissioned a statue that will be installed on the Pier to commemorate Lowestoft fishermen that have lost their lives at sea. The statue is ready to be installed however ESC has insisted on full engineers report ahead of installation. The engineers' fees are £1,050. We have approached ESC to try and get the fees paid for out of the Town's Fund but with no luck.
