<p><b>Key issues discussed at the meeting(s) (relevant to LTC and its constituents)</b></p>	<p>This being the AGM of Line Group North, most of the itinerary revolved around re-election of officers (Trevor Garrod chair; Tim Miller vice-chair), finance and governance.</p> <p>Suffolk County Council handles the accounts, but was criticised for tardy payments of both subsidies and claims for expenses.</p> <p>The East Suffolk Line has three groups – North, South and Felixstowe. There has not been a Community Partnership Officer for over a year to administer the three groups. SCC has re-advertized the post more widely, and at a higher salary (if any Town Councillor fancies the job).</p> <p>The ESTA information leaflets, for which LTC contributed towards the printing cost of that for Lowestoft &amp; Oulton Broad, are now being distributed around the town.</p>
<p><b>Any actions required by LTC?</b></p>	<p>Michael Winter has been advised that Martin Halliday, the Wherry Lines CPO, would like to meet him regarding events in general at Lowestoft Station, and the 175 Anniversary in particular.</p>
