

Below is a .pdf version of the Sports Facilities survey with notes on how parts of the survey will work in the online version (which will be more interactive). This survey has been designed to try and capture as much relevant data as possible to do with improving sports provision within Lowestoft. The survey covers the main LTC sites where sports facilities currently exist (Clarke's Lane, Denes Oval, Fen Park, Gunton Community Park, Kensington Gardens, Normanston Park, Rosedale Park and Sparrows Nest) and asks what they like/dislike in each park, how often the existing facilities are used and what new facilities people would like in each park. The survey makes some suggestions on new facilities but also allows for people to make their own suggestions and add other comments.

In order to make the survey manageable for people who may not wish to answer questions on every site, the survey has options throughout to skip each park.

This large survey (the whole survey includes 199 questions), hopefully covers a number of survey suggestions that have been put forward, including surveys on the assault course in Fen Park, the possible inclusion of gym equipment/teenage equipment at Rosedale Park, support and possible locations for a pump track and petanque piste, and future refurbishment/repurposing of the Normanston Park changing rooms.

The aim would be to share the survey with various groups, including sports clubs/groups and 'friends of' groups alongside having some "in-person" engagement events at the sites to encourage people who use the parks to complete the survey. It would be recommended that this survey has a long consultation time (at least six weeks) to allow for the engagement events and for comprehensive engagement in the survey.



Sports Facilities Provision in Parks in Lowestoft

Lowestoft Town Council are seeking public opinion on sports facilities within our parks and open spaces.

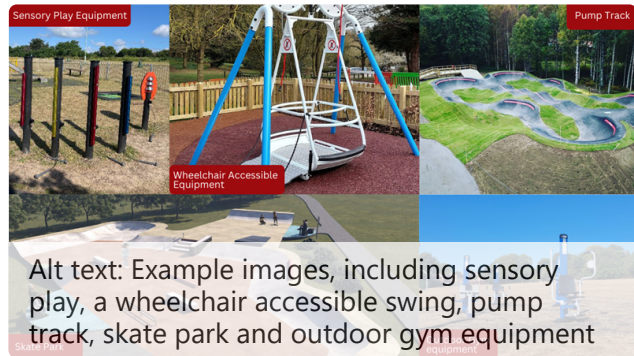

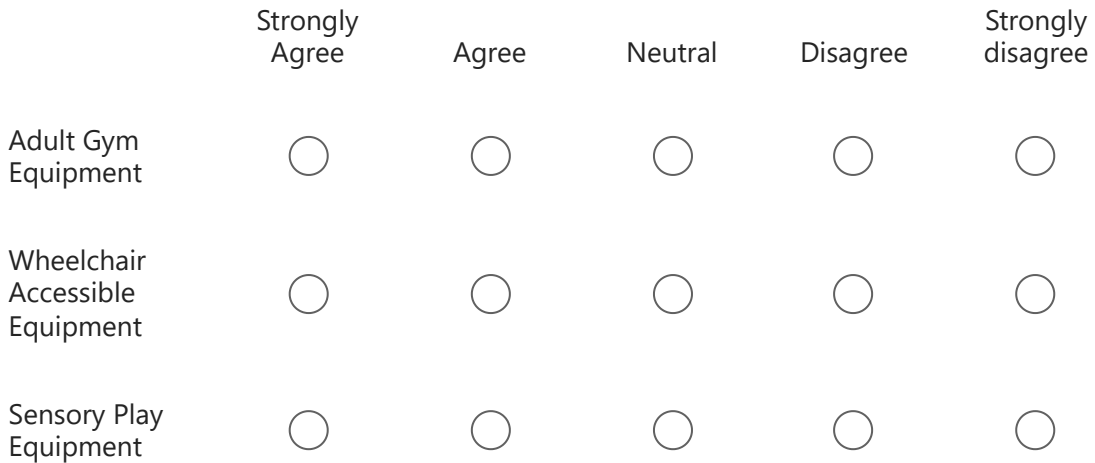

Gunton Community Park



The history of Gunton Community Park is an interesting one. In 1944, Lowestoft Borough Council bought 89 acres of Park Farm and the Warnes' estate by compulsory purchase. Immediately after the end of the Second World War, construction of the Gunton Estate began in order to resolve a critical shortage of housing. The roads of the estate were laid by German prisoners of war. The remaining rural land formed between Hollingsworth Road and the loop of Montgomery Avenue was developed as a recreational ground during the 1960's, though some of the eastern area was lost later to housing development near the water tower.

The remaining area, now known as Gunton Community Park, is criss-crossed by well-used footpaths, with two, well-equipped and popular sports and play areas for children of all ages in the centre. The southwestern quadrant boasts a pair of football goals whilst there are also new trees in the park, planted as part of the Queen's Green Canopy.

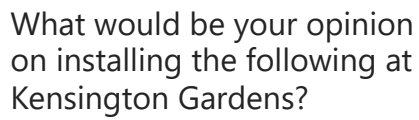

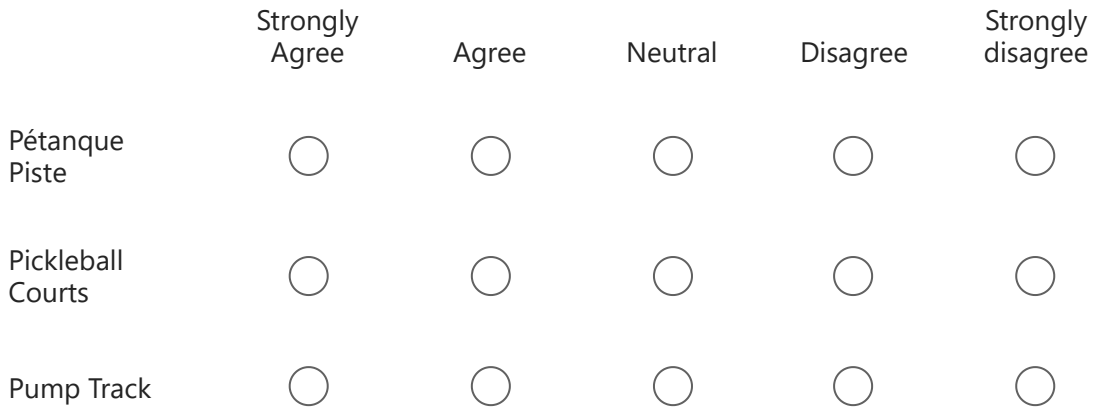

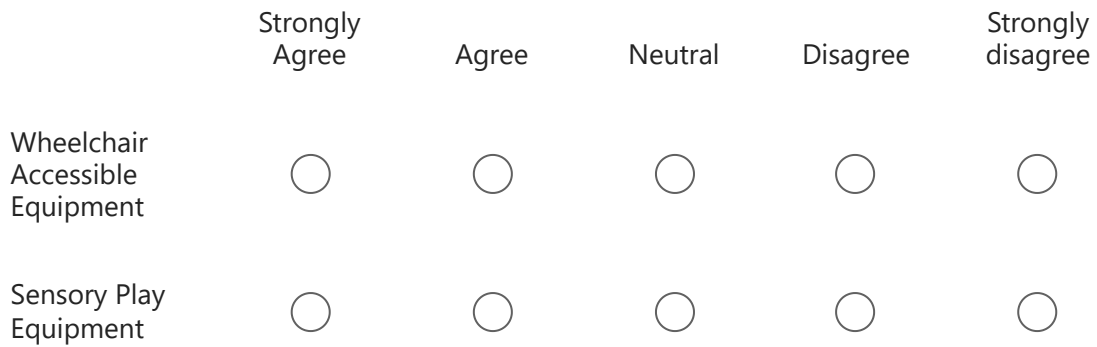
