

## **SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, LOWESTOFT) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES, ONE-WAY TRAFFIC AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2023**

Suffolk County Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1) and (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

### **PART 1: INTERPRETATION**

1. In this Order:

'goods vehicle' has the same meaning as in Section 138(3) of the Act of 1984.

2. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.

### **PART 2: PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES (WITH EXEMPTIONS)**

3. Except as provided in Articles 5, 6, 7 and 8, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in any direction in the length of road specified in Schedule 1.
4. Except as provided in Articles 5, 6 and 9, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in any direction in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2.
5. Nothing in Articles 3 or 4 shall make it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified therein if the vehicle:
  - (a) is to be used for police operational, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road and is to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition purposes;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road;
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (c) cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road and is to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
6. Nothing in Articles 3 or 4 shall make it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified therein if the vehicle is being used by an owner, occupant, or employee of a business or residential property adjacent to those



lengths of road and is authorised to do so by East Suffolk Council for the purposes of loading and unloading goods.

7. Nothing in Article 3 shall make it unlawful for any person to cause or permit between the hours of 4.00 p.m. and 10.00 a.m. only, any goods vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified therein if the vehicle is being used to gain access to or egress from land or premises situated in that length of road for the purposes of loading or unloading goods.
8. Nothing in Article 3 shall make it unlawful for a person to permit a security vehicle being used to make a collection or delivery to premises situated in the length of road specified in that Article to proceed in that length of road.
9. Nothing in Article 4 shall make it unlawful for a person to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified therein if the vehicle is being used in connection with the market and is authorised to do so by East Suffolk Council for the purposes of setting up and dismantling of market stalls only.

### **PART 3: ONE WAY TRAFFIC (EXCEPT FOR PEDAL CYCLES)**

10. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3 in a direction other than that specified in Column 2 of that Schedule.

### **PART 4: REVOCATIONS AND CITATION**

11. The provisions of The District of Waveney (St Peters Street, Old Market Plain, Old Market Street, High Street, Lowestoft) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Prohibition of Driving) (Prohibition and Restriction of Entry) and (One Way) Order 1998, insofar as they relate to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4, are hereby revoked.
12. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Various Roads, Lowestoft) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading, Additional Measures and Consolidation) Order 2005, insofar as they relate to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5, are hereby revoked.
13. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Various Roads, Lowestoft) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading, Prohibition of Driving with Exemptions, Parking Places and Suspension) order 2005, insofar as they relate to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 6, are hereby revoked.
14. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Gordon Road, Lowestoft) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading, Prohibition of Driving with Exemptions, Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2007, insofar as they relate to the length of road specified in Schedule 7, are hereby revoked.
15. This Order may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (Various Roads, Lowestoft) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles, One Way Traffic and Revocation) Order 2023

### SCHEDULE 1

**Prohibition of Motor Vehicles (except for loading by goods vehicles between 4.00 p.m. and 10.00 a.m.)**

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
London Road North (6U6169)	From a point 37 metres north east of the centre of its junction with Regent Road to a point on the southern side of its junction with Milton Road East.

### SCHEDULE 2

**Prohibition of Motor Vehicles**

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
High Street (6U6154 & 6U6233)	From a point 5 metres south of the southern kerb line of the east/west section of St Peters Street in a southerly direction to its junction with the A47 Artillery Way.
Triangle Market	From a point 5 metres south of the southern kerb line of the east/west section of St Peters Street, that triangular shaped area bounded by High Street to the east and the footway outside Nos. 122 and 123 High Street and Nos. 1-11 (odd) St Peters Street to the west.

### SCHEDULE 3

**One Way Traffic (with exemption for cycles)**

COLUMN 1 DESCRIPTION OF ROAD	COLUMN 2 PERMITTED DIRECTION OF TRAVEL
High Street (6U6154 & 6U6233)  From its junction with the east/west section of St Peters Street (the old 'Triangle Link Road') in a southerly direction to its junction with the A47 Artillery Way.	In a southerly direction.



#### **SCHEDULE 4**

##### **Revocation of Prohibition of Driving**

(from Schedule 8 of the Order cited in Article 11)

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
High Street	On the east/west fork from its junction with St Peters Street/Old Market Plain in an easterly direction to its junction with the north/south fork of the High Street.
Old Market Plain / St Peters Street	From a point 95.2 metres south east of its junction with Old Market Street in a south easterly direction for a distance of 34.8 metres.

##### **Revocation of Prohibition of Motor Vehicles 10.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Inclusive**

(from Schedule 9 of the Order cited in Article 11)

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
High Street (6U6154 & 6U6233)	From its junction with the Triangle Link Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Artillery Way.

##### **Revocation of Prohibition of Motor Vehicles except for loading Midnight to 10.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. to Midnight Inclusive**

(from Schedule 10 of the Order cited in Article 11)

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
High Street (6U6154 & 6U6233)	From its junction with the Triangle Link Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Artillery Way.

##### **Revocation of One-Way System (All Vehicles)**

(from the Order cited in Article 11)

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
High Street (6U6154 & 6U6233)	From its junction with the Triangle Link Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Artillery Way.

## SCHEDULE 5

### **Revocation of Prohibition of Vehicles (except for security vehicles at all times and goods vehicles and cycles 4.00 p.m. to 10.00 a.m.)**

(from Schedule 3 of the Order cited in Article 12)

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
London Road North (6U6169)	From a point 29 metres north of its junction with Regent Road in a northerly direction to its junction with Milton Road East.

### **Revocation of Prohibition of Vehicles (except for permit-holders, security vehicles and access to specific premises at all times; and for goods vehicles and cycles 4.00 p.m. to 10.00 a.m.)**

(from Schedule 4 of the Order cited in Article 12)

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
London Road North (6U6169)	From its junction with Regent Road in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 29 metres.

## SCHEDULE 6

### **Revocation of Prohibition of Vehicles (except for buses, taxis, security vehicles, disabled persons' vehicles and access to specific premises at all times; and for goods vehicles and cycles 4.00 p.m. to 10.00 a.m.)**

(from Schedule 2 of the Order cited in Article 13)

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
London Road North (6U6169)	From its junction with Gordon Road (U151) in a northerly direction to a point on the southern side of its junction with Regent Road (U333).

### **Revocation of Prohibition of Vehicles (except for permit holders, buses, taxis, goods vehicles, security vehicles, disabled persons' vehicles and access to specific premises at all times)**

(from Schedule 3 of the Order cited in Article 13)

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
London Road North (6U6169)	From a point on the southern side of its junction with Regent Road (U333) in a northerly direction to a point on the northern side of its junction with Regent Road (U333).
Regent Road (6U6165)	From its junction with London Road North (U646) in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 32 metres.

## SCHEDULE 7

**Revocation of Prohibition of Driving (except for buses, security vehicles, taxis, private hire vehicles, permit holders and disabled persons' vehicles at all times; and for goods vehicles 4.00 p.m. to 10.00 a.m.)**

(from Schedule 2 of the Order cited in Article 14)

ROAD	DESCRIPTION
Gordon Road (6U6237)	From a point 14 metre south east of a point adjacent to the boundary between Nos. 16 and 18 Gordon Road in a south-easterly direction to a point 58 metres south east of the eastern building line of London Road North, a distance of approximately 143 metres.
