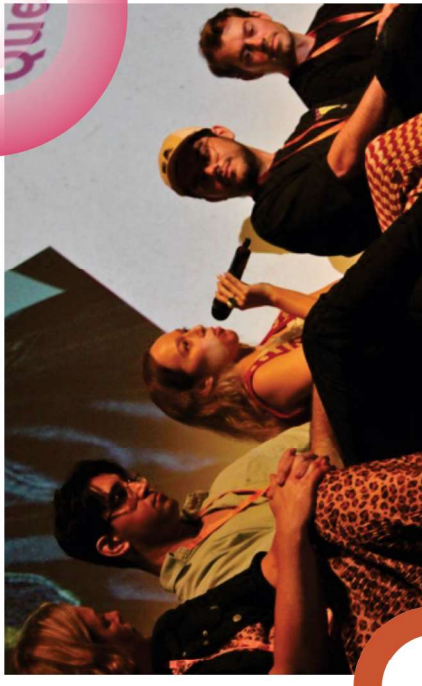


SUNRISE FILM FESTIVAL 2024 REPORT



ABOUT US

Sunrise Film Festival, based in Lowestoft Suffolk, is a nationally recognised film festival founded in 2021 by two passionate creatives, Joshua Freemantle and Patrick Johnson of Sunrise Studios, part of Access Community Trust.

Despite the challenges facing the film industry, the festival continues to create a dedicated vibrant platform for emerging filmmakers and making independent cinema accessible to new audiences in across audiences that typically wouldn't engage with or be able to afford to watch independent film.

Since our inception, we've now proudly screened over 420 independently produced films and presented 44 awards, and in 2024 most recently becoming a BIFA-qualifying accredited festival.

We continue to be backed by the BFI Film Audience Network and have been named by Film Hub South East as the exemplary festival for engagement with low socioeconomic audiences.

REFLECTIONS

Our outdoor cinemas as part of this year's festival were a huge success this year, both screenings sold out, and because of demand we had to hire more headsets, increasing our capacity from 100 people per screening to 130.

It worked incredibly well to bring back screenings of feature films that would engage with a wider audience across our local area, and allow them to discover something new at the same time by screening independent short films before each film. We want to continue this legacy next year by screening more feature films, and include the re-introduction of some carefully selected screenings of at least 2 independent feature films.

We also noticed an increase in local audience numbers from across Lowestoft and the local Waveney district, across the 4 days it was identified through the box office system that audience members who had pre-booked for screenings before the festival, resulted in 298 new people attending screenings that hadn't engaged with our previous activities across the past 3 years.

Our 2024 festival attendance figures clearly demonstrate that going down from 7 days to 4 days has a positive effect on higher attendance at this year's festival, and we'd arguably say that it was the most well attended festival edition we've had to date.

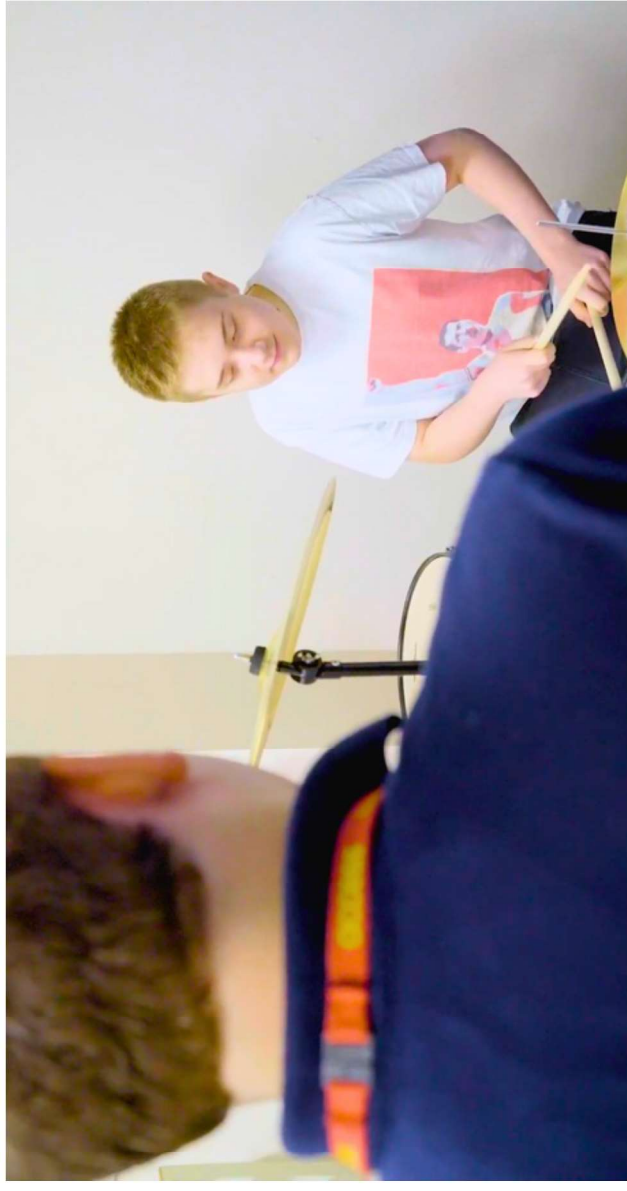
ABOUT
