About your project				
Please provide details of the project and how the project will benefit the people of Lowestoft (250 words max).	KPF has sub-groups which tackle issues that have been identified through consultation with the community:  The Kirkley Conversation ensures that the voice of Kirkley people is always heard and listened to. It manages a "Kirkley Conversation" Facebook group, hosts a weekly drop-in session (with regular visits from local Police, Councillors, etc.), and consultation with our community (polls, surveys, questionnaires).  Kirkley Youth provide a weekly "youth club" for 14-19 year olds. Currently 15 young people attend regularly. When they were asked, young people said they wanted a safe space with activities. Expansion up to 20 young people is forecast for next year.  Enabling Kirkley aims to improve accessibility for all people affected by disability (physical, mental, sensory impairment etc.). The "Improving Accessibility by Increasing Awareness" initiative has awarded certificates and window stickers to more than 20 Kirkley businesses who have made a change. In the next year it is planned to roll out the project across other Kirkley businesses including the hospitality industry.  Kirkley Photography Group meets weekly. It is a supportive, friendly, group of people of varying age and expertise. Everyone is welcome. Group members give each other excellent support and			



	encouragement. They have arranged outings and document KPF events.  There are 2 pilot projects underway. These are Kirkley Landlords and Tenants Group and Technology Support Group.  In addition to the above there are 6 'supported groups' some of which KPF originally set up but are now formally constituted. These groups are:- Friends of Kensington Gardens, Friends of Fen Park, Pocket Parks Group, TrueColours, Suffolk Sober Spaces and a support group for people in recovery from addiction.
